#### Constitutional changes-

#### 1.9 Orientation Camp.

#### Rename sections

1.9 Bulletin becomes 1.10 Bulletin becomes 1.11 A.G.M.

- 1.9.1 The committee, in conjunction with the elected Orientation Camp Convenors, shall hold an Orientation Camp each year.
- 1.9.2 The committee shall help select leaders and cooks to help conduct the orientation camp. These leaders and cooks should be those people who show most enthusiasm in advancing the clubs reputation and involving themselves with the club activities.
- 1.9.3 The committee may recommend candidates for leaders and cooks to the convenors. The names of all applicants or interested persons should be made available to the committee. When the convenors have made their final selection, the committee must approve the choices.



- 1.9.4 All expenditure for Orientation Camp shall be approved by the Honorary Treasurer or the President.
- 1.9.5 The committee may allow a small amount of money to be made available to the Orientation Camp convenors for use in emergency situations only. Such use shall be reported to the committee at the earliest possible occasion, with supporting evidence of its use.

Orientation Camp convenors may not have direct access to the clubs bank accounts during the orientation camp.
