'I'll attend all my tutes (even when they don't mark attendance)'

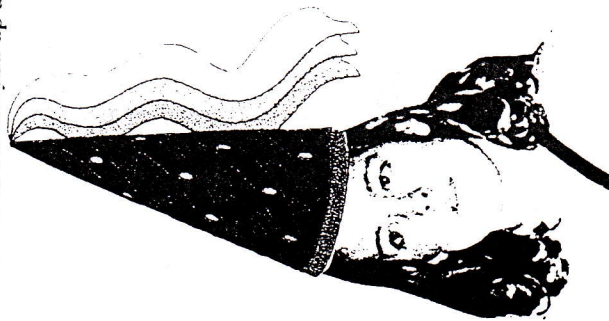
'If I miss a lecture or tute, I'll catch the notes up the very next day'

AUSCA EVENTS TO LOOK FORWARD TO THIS YEAR:

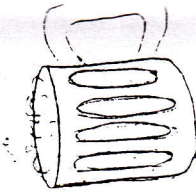
OAKBANK

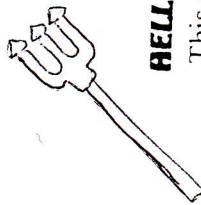
AUSCA PUBCRAWL

Crawl being the operative word here! Come and enjoy the Adelaide pub scene with your favourite AUScA personalities sometime in first term.



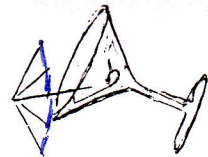
HELL PARTY

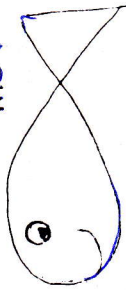


PYJONGATAIL PARTY

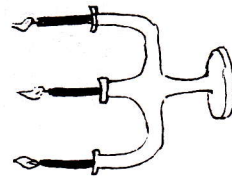
WINERY TOUR

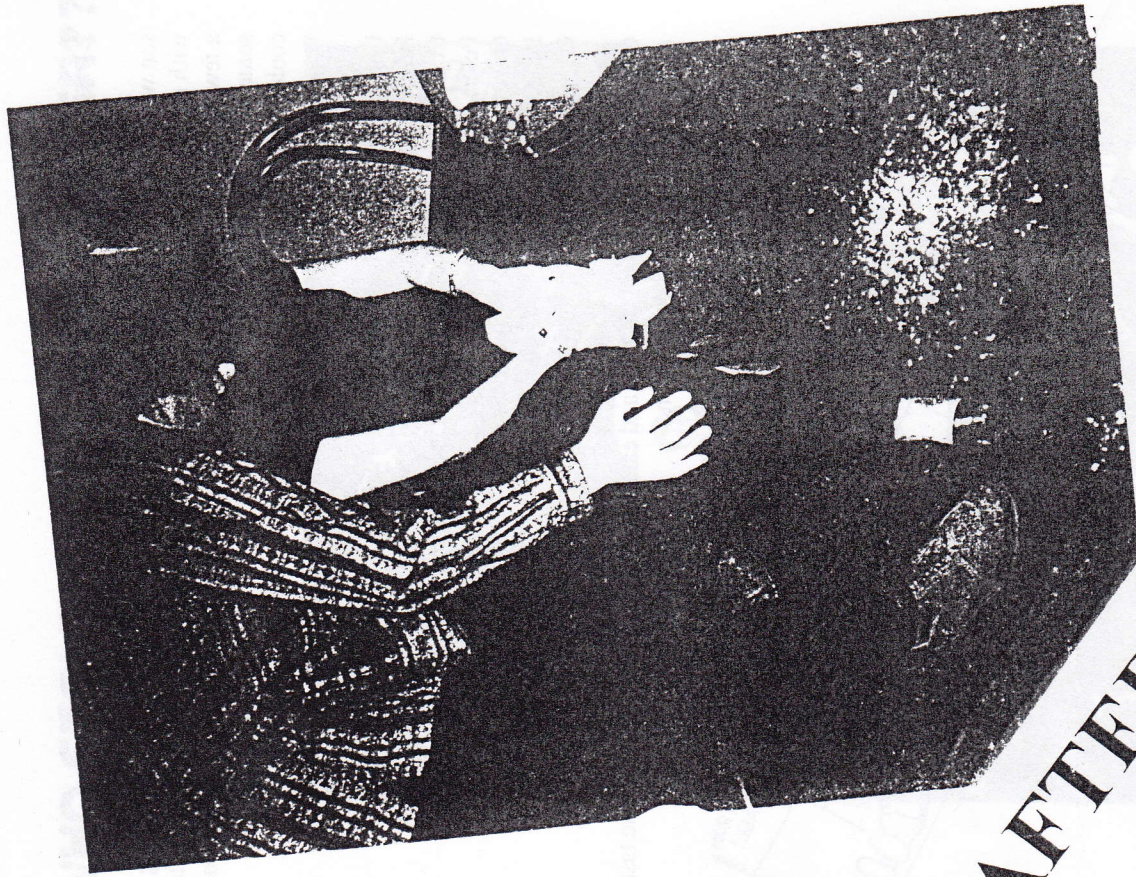

Cornelius: Maybe because Oliver is looking a little green.

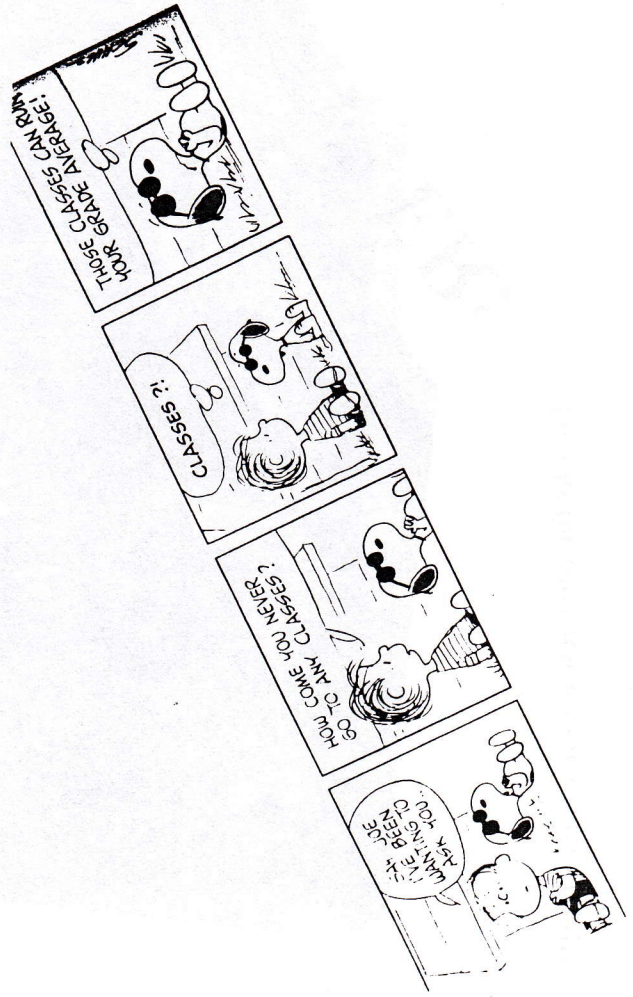
Peter: I can't be bothered.

Oliver: Blaah! Cough! Splutter! Spit!

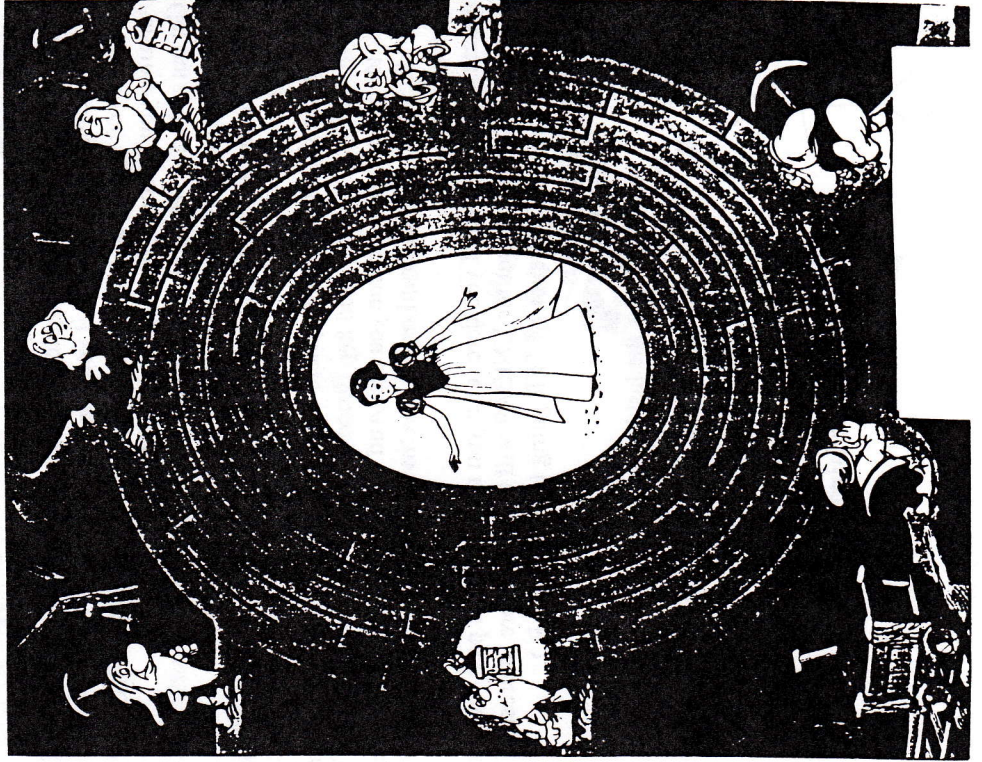
Peter: Oh Shit!!! Get it off me! Get it off!

Oliver rips a tomato off its bush and eats it, in an attempt to get rid of the taste. A hush falls upon the veggie patch.



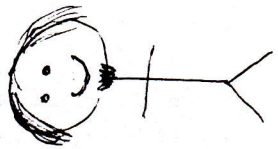

(He reaches for the nearest broccoli)

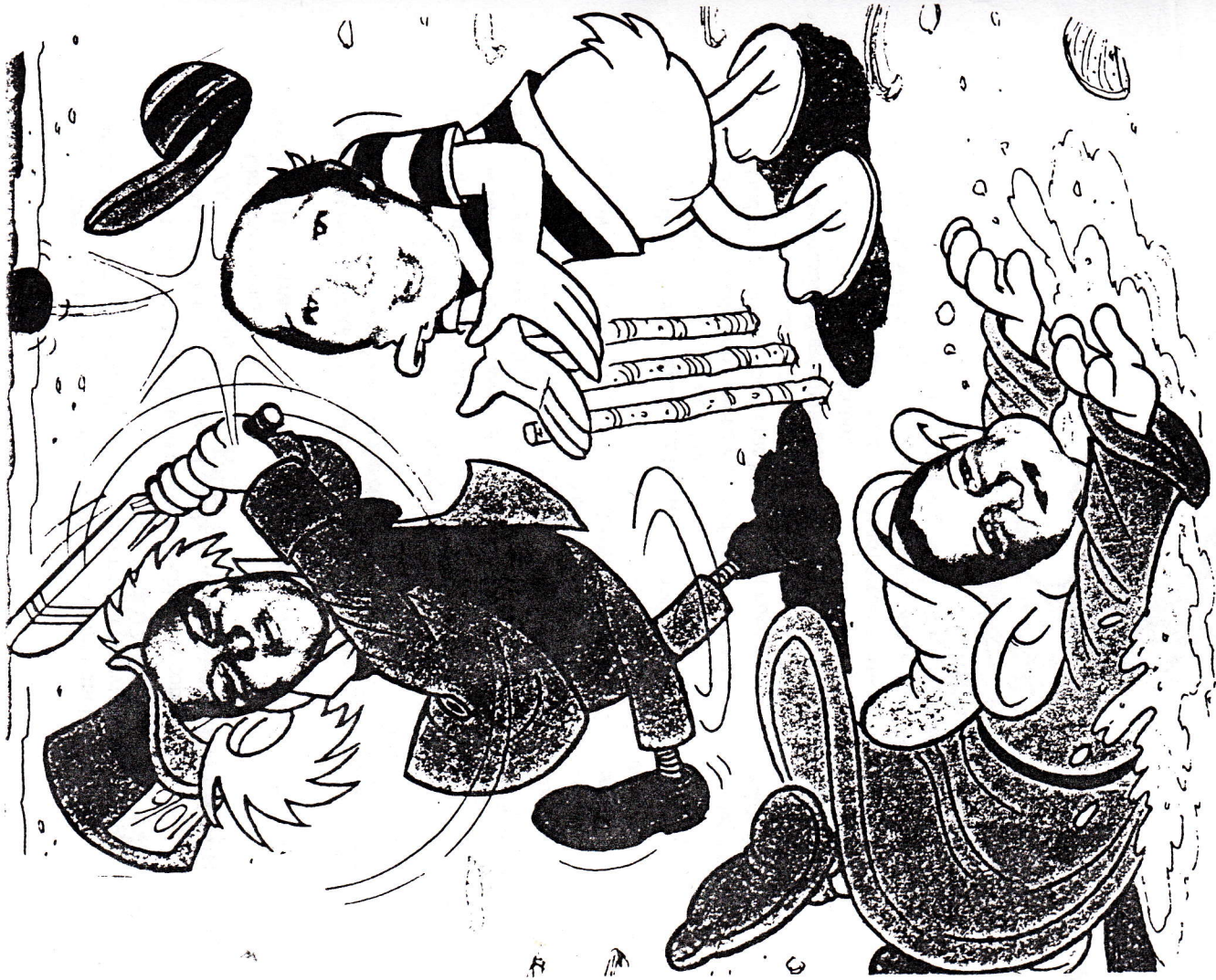
Hey Bernadette how 'bout it?
