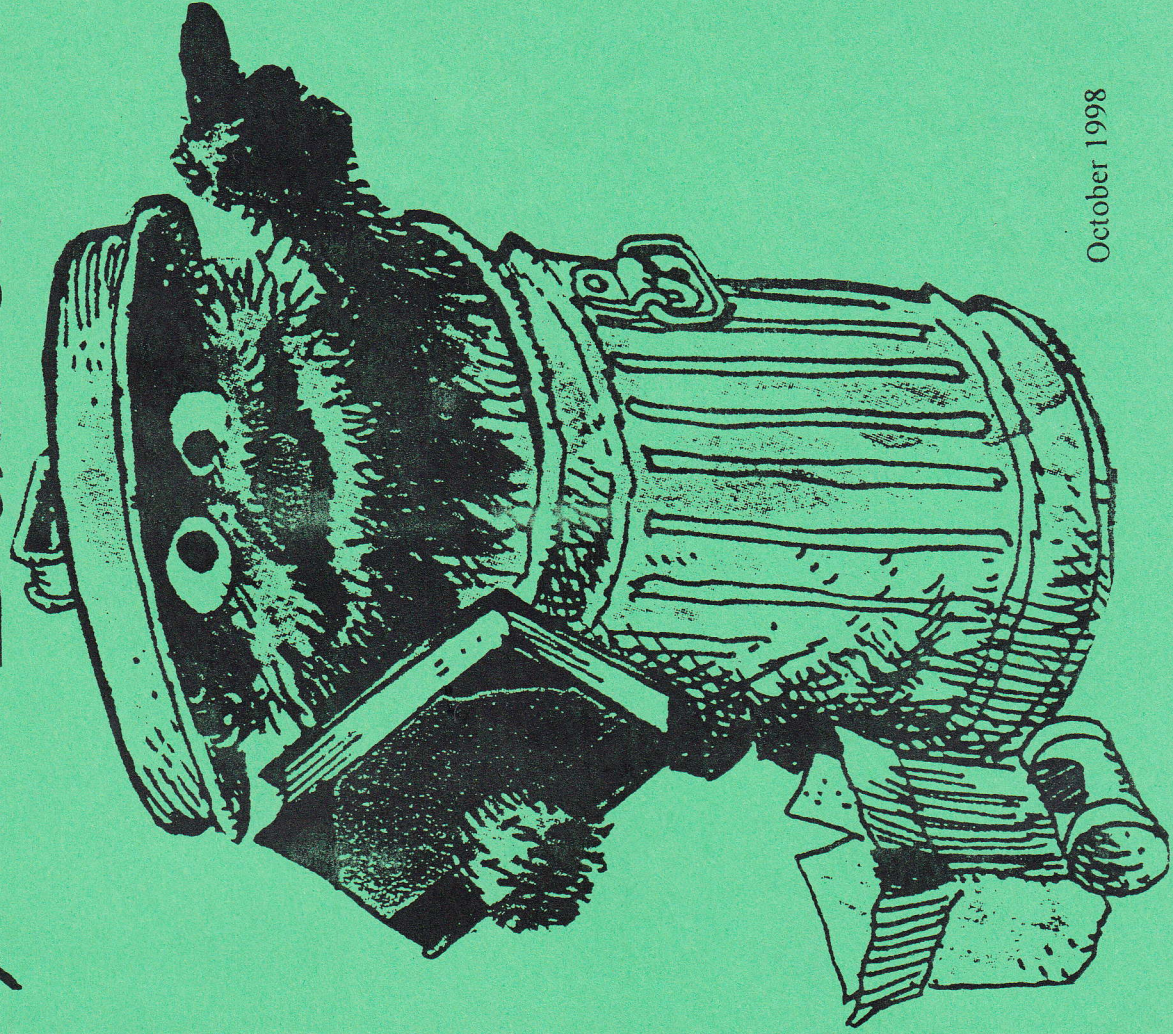

Apparently Fish and Sarah made a lot of noise! FUN was had by all and I hear the pancakes were good! Technically the only rules broken were:

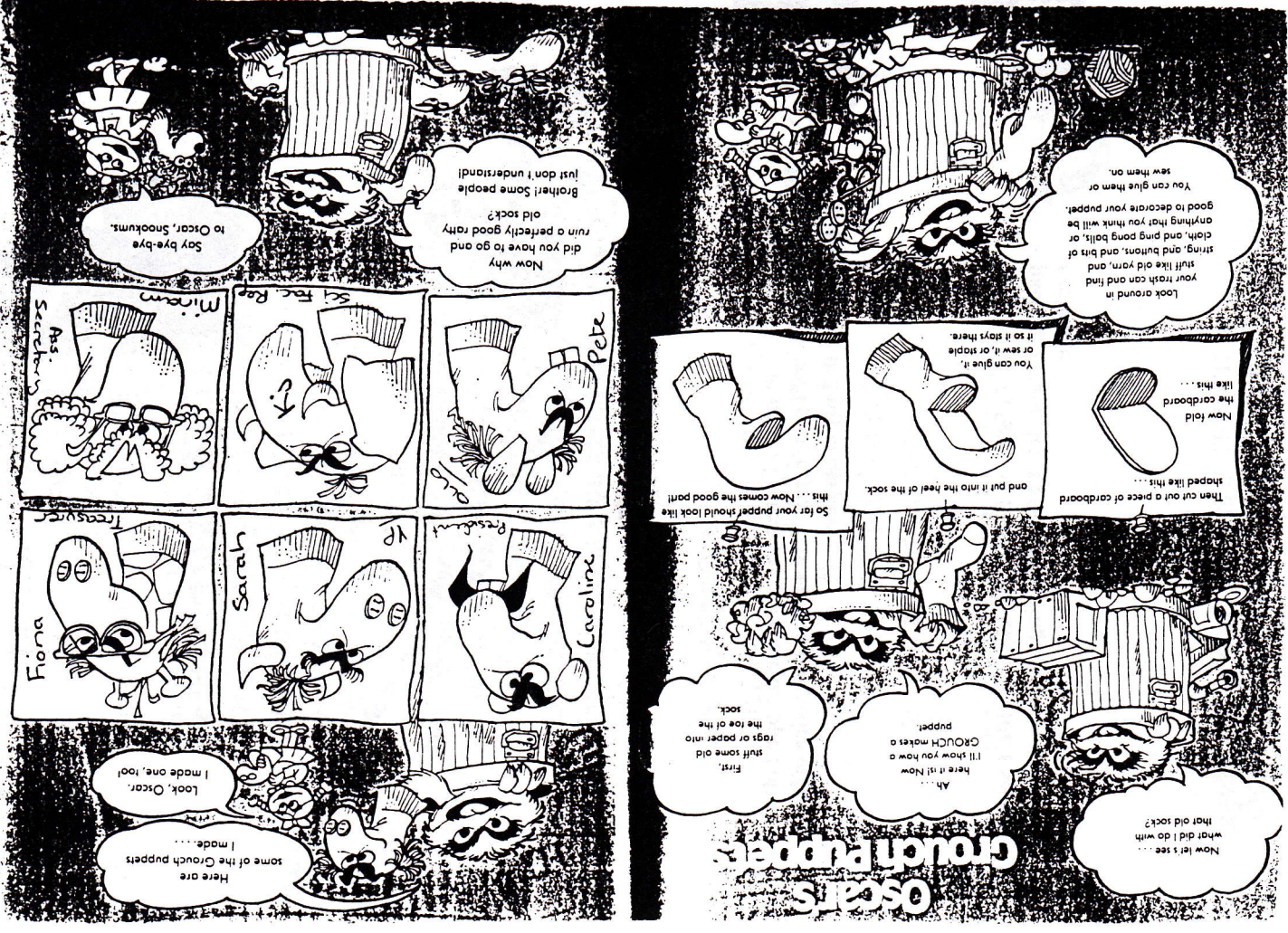
- no person shall behave in a disorderly, offensive, or indecent manner, or create any disturbance on the campsite.

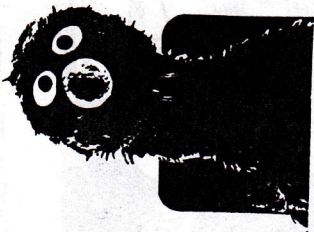
But anyway I heard it was good....And I wasn't there!!

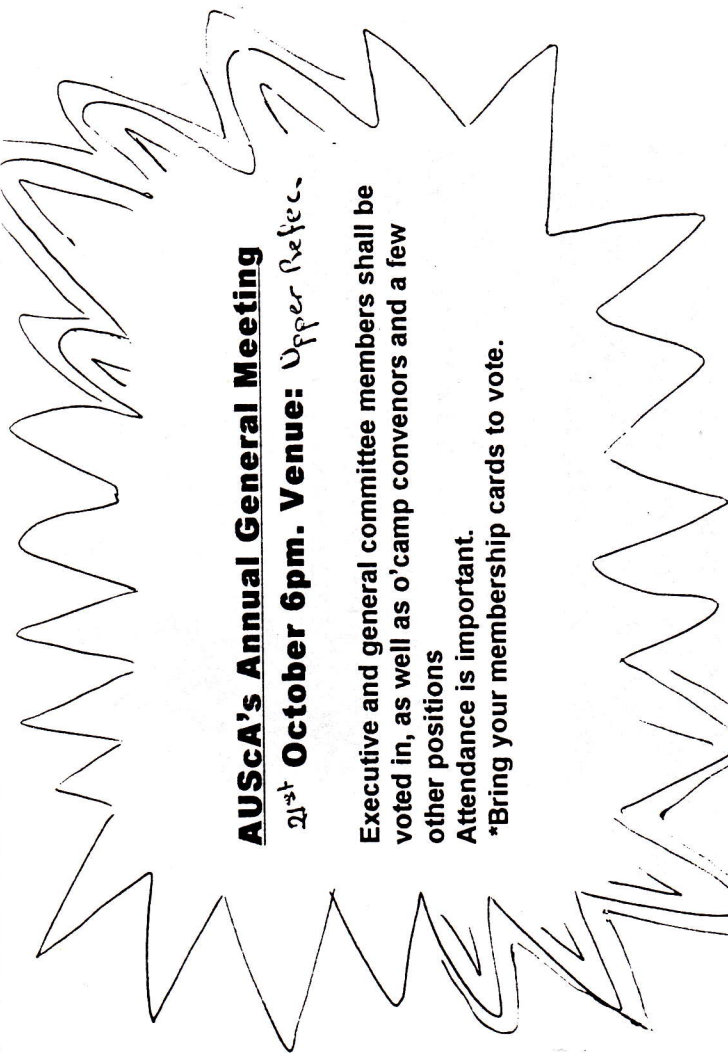
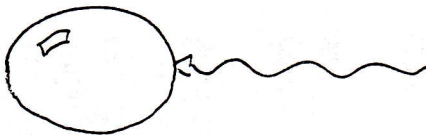
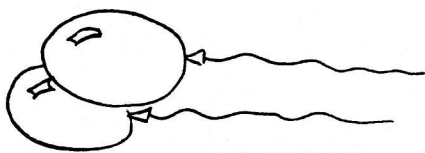
Kerry and Nicole's joint 18th Party.
