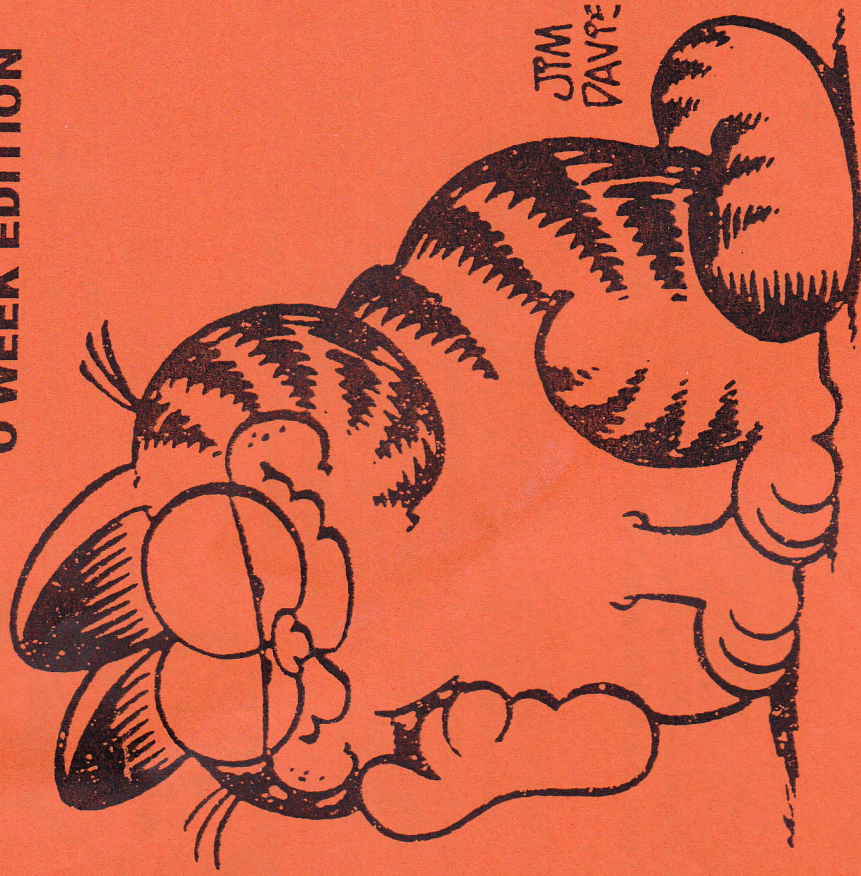

President's Report

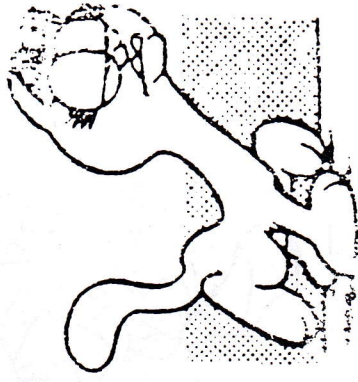

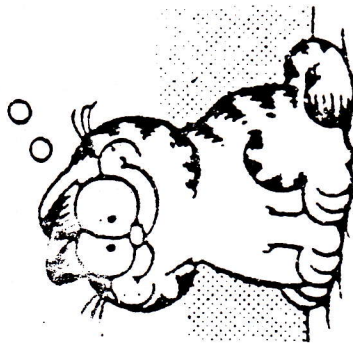
AUScA's 1999 MAIN EVENTS

Garfield's wit and wisdom either tends to his selfish ways or disguises his own lazy personality. This would explain why Garfield believes that:

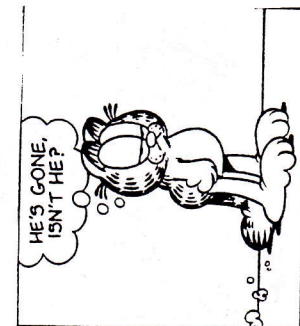
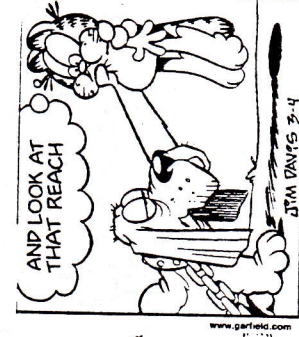
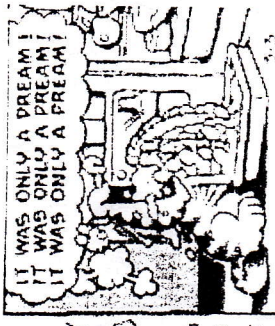
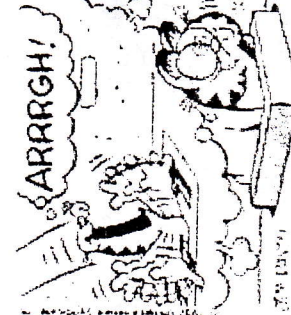
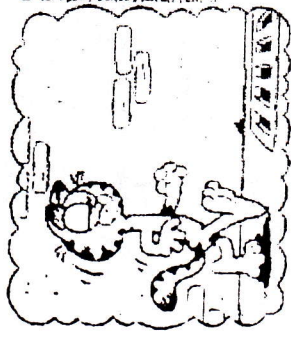

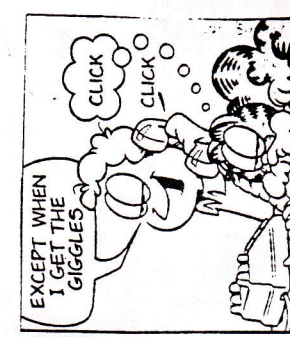
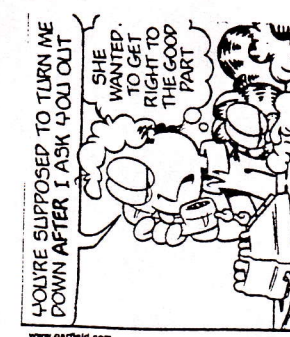
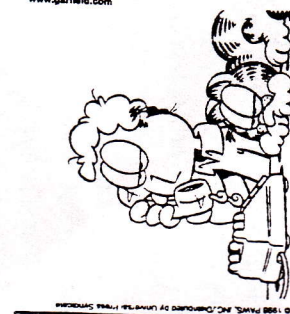
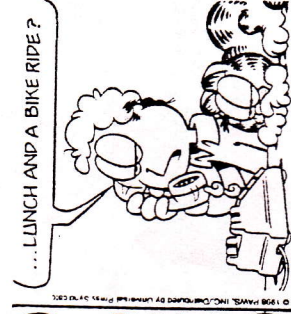
Garfield has as many nightmares as the rest of us. His worst nightmares would have to include:
