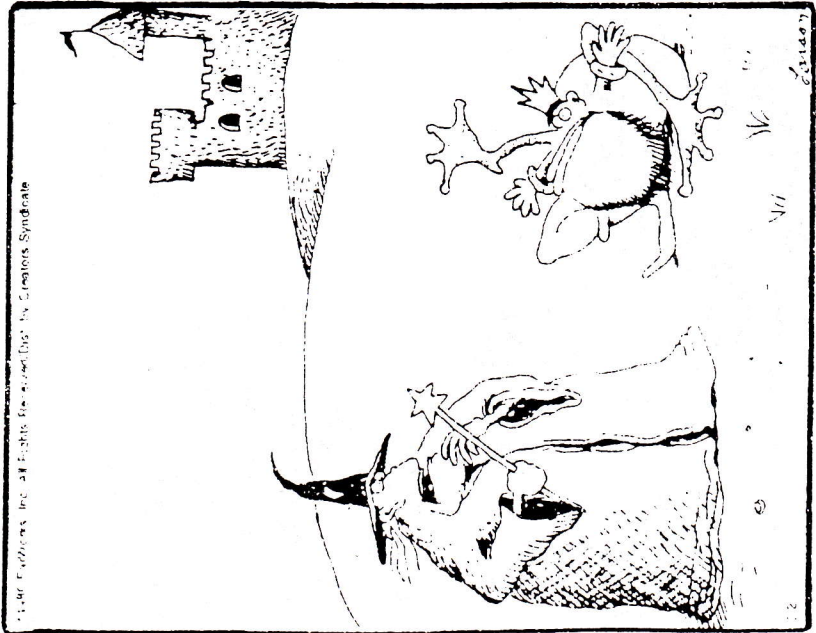
# A Word From the editor
